- 1) Subject comes first, verb last.
- 2) Verb **है** is used with pronouns **वह** and **यह** and with any singular noun.

वह (vah) = that/ he / she/ it (further away)

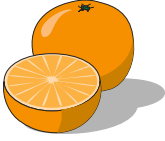
यह (yah) = this/ he/she/it (near)

है (hai) = is
